Reduces the influx of women as sex slaves into Israel from the Former Soviet Union by empowering women at the grassroots level through education, advocacy, and legislation; this cutting-edge social action project improves the lives of all women in Israeli society.

Jerusalem Shelter for Battered Women

Empowering Battered Women to Break the Cycle of Violence in Their Lives \$13,000

Educates battered women after they leave the shelter, helps their children escape the cycle of violence, and works to prevent further violence through emotional and financial empowerment.

Haifa Rape Crisis Center Youth Violence Prevention Project \$5,000

Educates 4th through 12th graders and school professionals on gender issues, sexuality, safe internet use, healthy relationships, and date rape; prevents future therapy and rehabilitation by investing in education.
